A bill to be entitled
An act relating to fees; amending s. 466.0225, F.S.;
revising the licensure requirements for dental
therapists to include application and examination
fees; providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 466.0225, Florida
Statutes, as created by SB ____, is amended to read:

466.0225 Examination of dental therapists; licensing.—

(1) Any person desiring to be licensed as a dental
therapist must apply to the department to take the licensure
examinations and shall verify the information required on the
application by oath. The application must include two recent
photographs of the applicant. There shall be a nonrefundable
application fee set by the board not to exceed \$100 and an
examination fee set by the board not to exceed \$225. The
examination fee may be refunded if the applicant is found
ineligible to take the examinations.

Section 2. This act shall take effect on the same date that
SB ____ or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation
is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension
thereof and becomes a law.
