- 2. Shall administer the statewide assessments pursuant to s. 1008.22 if the private school chooses to offer the statewide assessments. A participating private school may choose to offer and administer the statewide assessments to all students who attend the private school in grades 3 through 10 and must submit a request in writing to the department by March 1 of each year in order to administer the statewide assessments in the subsequent school year.
- (c) May not operate as, or be operated by, a for-profit corporation or a for-profit educational management organization.
  - 1. As used in this paragraph, the term:
- a. "For-profit educational management organization" means an entity that manages or operates a private school.
- b. "Operate as" or "be operated by" means the provision of services by a for-profit corporation or a for-profit educational management organization including any of the following:
- (I) The nomination, appointment, or removal of board members or officers of the school.
- (II) The employment, supervision, or dismissal of employees or contractors of the school, including certificated and noncertified school personnel.
