21 (g)1. A trade secret, as defined in s. 688.002, which is
 22 used in designing and constructing a hurricane or flood loss
 23 model and which is provided pursuant to this section, by a
 24 private company, to the commission, office, or consumer advocate
 25 appointed pursuant to s. 627.0613 is confidential and exempt
