22 (b) A school guardian has no authority to act in any law
23 enforcement capacity except to the extent necessary to prevent
24 or abate an active assailant incident on school premises.
25 Individuals who serve as school guardians are in support of
26 school-sanctioned activities for purposes of s. 790.115. School
27 guardians shall:
28 <u>1. Hold a valid license issued under s. 790.06 or a Class</u>
29 "D" and "G" license pursuant to chapter 493;
30 2. Successfully complete the training for school guardians
31 required under s. 943.1712;
32 <u>3. Pass a psychological evaluation administered by a</u>
33 psychologist licensed under chapter 490 and designated by the
