However, this section does not prohibit survivors or the estate of the decedent from presenting a claim bill for approval by the Legislature in addition to the death benefits provided in this section. Each member of the Florida National Guard who is killed, or who dies as the result of injuries incurred, while on active duty qualifies for benefits as a member of the United States Armed Forces under s. 295.061, and the decedent's survivors or estate are entitled to the death benefits provided in s. 295.061.
