22 applicable judicial circuit; and Public Defender, with the  
23 applicable judicial circuit.

24           4. The office titles of State Senator and State  
25 Representative, with the applicable district for the office  
26 printed beneath.

27           5. The office titles of Clerk of the Circuit Court or,  
28 when the Clerk of the Circuit Court also serves as the County  
29 Comptroller, Clerk of the Circuit Court and Comptroller, when  
30 authorized by law; Clerk of the County Court, when authorized by  
31 law; Sheriff; Property Appraiser; Tax Collector; District  
32 Superintendent of Schools; and Supervisor of Elections.

33           6. The office titles of Board of County Commissioners,  
34 with the applicable district printed beneath each office, and  
35 such other county and district offices as are involved in the  
36 election, in the order fixed by the Department of State,  
37 followed, in the year of their election, by "Party Offices," and  
38 thereunder the offices of state and county party executive  
39 committee members.
