A bill to be entitled

An act relating to third-party agreements in civil proceedings; creating s. 45.081, F.S.; requiring parties to civil actions to provide copies of certain third-party agreements to the other parties, except when otherwise ordered by the court; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 45.081, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

stipulated or ordered by the court, a party to any civil action, without awaiting a discovery request, shall provide to the other parties a copy of any agreement under which any person, other than an attorney retained on a contingency-fee basis to represent a party to the action, has a right to receive compensation that is contingent upon and sourced from any proceeds of the civil action, whether by settlement, judgment, or otherwise.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
