1 House Resolution 2 A resolution designating the week of April 28-May 5, 3 2019, as the "Days of Remembrance" and May 2, 2019, as "Holocaust Remembrance Day" in the State of Florida. 4 5 6 WHEREAS, the Holocaust, the state-sponsored, systematic 7 persecution and annihilation of European Jewry by Nazi Germany 8 and its collaborators between 1933 and 1945, resulted in the 9 murder of six million Jews, and 10 WHEREAS, in addition, Roma (Gypsies) and Poles were targeted for decimation for racial, ethnic, or national reasons, 11 12 and millions more, including persons with disabilities, 13 homosexuals, Jehovah's Witnesses, Soviet prisoners of war, and 14 political dissidents, suffered grievous oppression and death 15 under Nazi tyranny, and WHEREAS, the history of the Holocaust offers an opportunity 16 17 to reflect on the moral responsibilities of individuals, 18 societies, and governments, particularly to remain vigilant 19 against hatred, persecution, and tyranny, and 20 WHEREAS, pursuant to an act of the United States Congress 21 (Public Law No. 96-388, October 7, 1980), the United States Holocaust Memorial Council has designated Sunday, April 28, 22 through Sunday, May 5, 2019, as the "Days of Remembrance" for 23 the victims of the Holocaust, including the Day of Remembrance 24 25 known as Yom HaShoah on May 2, 2019, and
