WHEREAS, the University of Florida has been ranked one of the top 10 public universities, rising from its Number 9 position in 2018 to Number 8 in 2019 on the U.S. News & World Report Top Public Schools list, and

WHEREAS, the University of Florida continues its upward momentum with a 40 percent increase in the number of graduate programs, listed among the top 30 programs nationwide in the 2020 U.S. News & World Report Best Graduate Schools rankings, and

WHEREAS, Professor Clifford Will of the University of Florida Department of Physics is bestowed the 2019 Albert Einstein Medal by the Albert Einstein Society in Bern, Switzerland, for his "important contributions to General Relativity," a prestigious award whose first recipient was Stephen Hawking, in 1979, and

WHEREAS, the University of Florida researchers led by Professors Z. Hugh Fan and John Lednicky have also made significant contributions to the advancement of science with the development of a simple, cost-effective device that could be

used at a physician's office to quickly identify Zika virus infection in a patient, and

 WHEREAS, a 2019 article in "Issues in Science and Technology" lists the University of Florida as one of the baccalaureate-origin institutions with the highest number of Hispanic graduates, as well as the highest number of African American graduates, who go on to earn doctorate degrees in the natural sciences and engineering fields between 2007 and 2016, the only institution that ranks among the top 10 on both demographics lists, and

WHEREAS, applications to the University of Florida once again reached a new record in 2019, with more than 41,000 prospective students vying for admission during the summer and fall semesters, and

WHEREAS, UF Online, the University of Florida's online bachelor's degree program, is tied for the Number 5 position in the country, up from Number 12 last year, in the 2019 U.S. News & World Report Best Online Programs rankings, and

WHEREAS, in March 2019, College Magazine recognized the University of Florida as having the 6th best campus for students with physical disabilities, and

WHEREAS, the University of Florida also distinguishes itself through its athletic program, listed among the nation's top 10 for 35 straight years and among the top 5 for 20 of the last 27 years, according to national all-sport rankings, and
