16	(3) The division shall adopt rules to create a state park
17	annual entrance pass program for individuals who perform
18	volunteer work related to nonnative and invasive plant species
19	removal. The division shall issue an annual entrance pass to all
20	state parks at no charge to individuals who perform at least 50
21	hours of volunteer work on conservation and recreation lands in
22	this state per year to remove nonnative and invasive plant
23	species. Such conservation and recreation lands may include, but
24	are not limited to, state parks, state forest lands, water
25	management district lands, Fish and Wildlife Conservation

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26	Commission conservation-managed lands, or other public lands
27	managed by the department. The volunteer work performed by the
28	individual must be consistent with the public land's management
29	plan and be conducted under the supervision of the division or
30	another appropriate land management agency. The rules must
31	include, at a minimum:
32	(a) Identification of the specific work that qualifies for
33	volunteer hours.
34	(b) A process to document and verify that the individual
35	performed at least 50 hours of volunteer work for nonnative and
36	invasive species removal on the public land before receiving an
37	annual entrance pass at no charge.
38	(c) A process to identify activities and locations
39	appropriate for volunteers consistent with each public land's
40	management plan.
41	(d) A process for supervising volunteer activities to
42	ensure the safety of the volunteers and that the work is
