6 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

7 Section 1. Section 395.1052, Florida Statutes, is created
 8 to read:

9 395.1052 Patient access to primary care or specialist
 10 provider; notification.—Each hospital shall:

11 (1) Notify the patient's primary care or specialist
 12 provider, if any, within 24 hours after the patient's admission
 13 to the hospital.

14 (2) Inform a patient immediately upon admission that he or
 15 she may request to have the treating physician at the hospital
 16 consult with the patient's primary care or specialist provider,

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17 if any, when developing the patient's plan of care. Upon the
18 patient's request, the treating physician at the hospital shall
19 make reasonable efforts to consult with the patient's primary
20 care or specialist provider when developing the patient's plan
21 of care.

22 (3) Notify the patient's primary care or specialist
23 provider, if any, of the patient's discharge from the hospital
24 within 24 hours after discharge.

25 (4) Provide the discharge summary and any related
26 information or records to the patient's primary care or
27 specialist provider, if any, within 7 days after the patient's
28 discharge from the hospital.

29 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.

34 An act relating to patient access to primary care and specialist
35 providers; creating s. 395.1052, F.S.; requiring a hospital to
36 notify a patient's primary care or specialist provider within a
37 specified timeframe after the patient's admission; requiring a
38 hospital to inform a patient, upon admission, of the option to
39 request consultation between the patient's primary care or
40 specialist provider and the treating physician at the hospital;
