Section 2. Beginning September 1, 2020, in order to implement the changes made by this act to s. 320.055, Florida Statutes, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles shall develop methodology to prorate motor vehicle registration renewal fees. The methodology shall give customers the option to renew their registration on their date of birth in 2021 or 2022. Customers whose date of birth is from January to June may choose to renew for 1 to 18 months. Customers whose date of birth is from July to December may choose to renew for 7 to 24 months.
