An act relating to restrictive covenants; creating s.
542.336, F.S.; providing that certain restrictive
covenants are void and unenforceable for a specified
period; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 542.336, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

542.336 Invalid restrictive covenants.—A restrictive covenant entered into with a physician licensed under chapter 458 or chapter 459 who practices a medical specialty in a county where one entity employs or contracts with, either directly or through related or affiliated entities, all physicians who practice such specialty in that county is not supported by a legitimate business interest and is void and unenforceable. Such restrictive covenant shall remain void and unenforceable for 3 years after the date on which a second entity that employs or contracts with, either directly or through related or affiliated entities, one or more physicians who practice such specialty begins serving patients in that county.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
