Section 1. Section 316.2128, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.2128 Operation of motorized scooters and miniature motorcycles; requirements for sales and rentals.-

(1) A person who engages in the business of, serves in the capacity of, or acts as a commercial seller of motorized scooters or miniature motorcycles in this state must prominently



display at his or her place of business a notice that such vehicles are not legal to operate on public roads, may not be registered as motor vehicles, and may not be operated on sidewalks unless authorized by an ordinance enacted pursuant to s. 316.008(7)(a) or s. 316.212(8). The required notice must also appear in all forms of advertising offering motorized scooters or miniature motorcycles for sale. The notice and a copy of this section must also be provided to a consumer prior to the consumer's purchasing or becoming obligated to purchase a motorized scooter or a miniature motorcycle.

- (2) Any person selling or offering a motorized scooter or a miniature motorcycle for sale in violation of this section commits an unfair and deceptive trade practice as defined in part II of chapter 501.
- (3) A county or municipality may not prohibit a business from offering motorized scooters or motorcycles for rent within the county's or municipality's jurisdiction unless approved by a supermajority vote of the governing body of the county or municipality.
