Said deductions shall 53 commence when the employer receives a signed authorization form 54 from the bargaining agent and is able to confirm with the 55 employee, electronically or by other means, that he or she 56 authorized the deduction of dues and uniform assessments upon 57 the bargaining agent's written request to the employer. 58 Reasonable costs to the employer of said deductions is shall be a proper subject of collective bargaining.
