12 on Public Counsel Oversight shall appoint a Public Counsel to 13 represent the general public of Florida before the Florida 14 Public Service Commission. The Public Counsel shall be an 15 attorney admitted to practice before the Florida Supreme Court, 16 and shall be appointed for a term of 4 years, and may be 17 reappointed thereafter, provided that a person appointed as the 18 Public Counsel may not serve more than 12 consecutive years in the position. However, the time served by the Public Counsel 19 20 before July 1, 2020, may not be considered in applying the limitation on consecutive years of service. The Public Counsel 21 22 shall be appointed by a majority vote of the committee 23 appointees of each house and may be removed from office by a 24 majority vote of the committee appointees of each house. A 25 person may continue as Public Counsel beyond the 4-year term 26 until his or her successor is appointed and takes office, unless 27 the person is removed by a vote of the committee. The Committee 28 on Public Counsel Oversight shall receive applications, conduct 29 interviews, and appoint a Public Counsel to a 4-year term 30 beginning on March 1, 2021, and every 4 years thereafter serve 31 at the pleasure of the Committee on Public Counsel Oversight, 32 subject to biennial reconfirmation by the committee.
