11 (e) A person who is not certified or registered may
12 perform the work of a specialty contractor, whose limited scope
13 of work falls under s. 489.105(3)(j)-(l), for the construction,
14 remodeling, repair, or improvement of commercial and residential
15 swimming pools, hot tubs, and spas, without obtaining a local
16 license or certification as a specialty contractor, provided the

17 person is supervised by a contractor certified or registered
 18 under s. 489.105(3)(j)-(l), the work is within the scope of the
 19 supervising contractor's license, the supervising contractor is
 20 responsible for the work, and the work does not require
 21 certification or registration under s. 489.105(3)(d)-(i), (m)-
 22 (o), or s. 489.505. Such supervision does not require a direct
 23 contract between the contractor certified or registered under s.
 24 489.105(3)(j)-(l) and the person performing the work, or for the
 25 person performing the work to be an employee of the contractor
 26 certified or registered under s. 489.105(3)(j)-(l). This
 27 subsection does not limit the exemptions provided in s. 489.103.
