An act relating to the Florida Job Growth Grant Fund; amending s. 288.101, F.S.; authorizing the Governor to approve workforce training grants to certain charter schools under the Florida Job Growth Grant Fund; amending s. 1002.33, F.S.; authorizing certain public schools to apply for specified grant funds; requiring grant funds to be used toward specified expenses; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (d) is added to subsection (2) of section 288.101, Florida Statutes, to read:

288.101 Florida Job Growth Grant Fund.-

- (2) The department and Enterprise Florida, Inc., may identify projects, solicit proposals, and make funding recommendations to the Governor, who is authorized to approve:
- (d) Workforce training grants to support programs at public schools that offer the Career and Technical Education graduation pathway option pursuant to s. 1003.4282(11). Such grants must be used only toward Career and Technical Education program expenses.

Section 2. Paragraph (i) is added to subsection (17) of section 1002.33, Florida Statutes, to read:

1002.33 Charter schools.-

(17) FUNDING.—Students enrolled in a charter school, regardless of the sponsorship, shall be funded as if they are in a basic program or a special program, the same as students
