6 Remove lines 357-375 and insert:

7 a. The notice must be prominently placed at each driveway
 8 access or curb cut allowing vehicular access to the property,
 9 within 10 ~~5~~ feet from the road as defined in s. 334.03(22)
 10 ~~public right-of-way line~~. If there are no curbs or access
 11 barriers, the signs must be posted not fewer ~~less~~ than one sign
 12 for each 25 feet of lot frontage.

13 b. The notice must clearly indicate, in not fewer ~~less~~
 14 than 2-inch high, light-reflective letters on a contrasting
 15 background, that unauthorized vehicles will be towed away at the

16 owner's expense. The words "tow-away zone" must be included on
17 the sign in not fewer ~~less~~ than 4-inch high letters.

18 c. The notice must also provide the name and current
19 telephone number of the person or firm towing or removing the
20 vehicles or vessels.

21 d. The sign structure containing the required notices
22 must be permanently installed with the words "tow-away zone" not
23 less than 3 feet and not more than 6 feet above ground level and
24 must be continuously maintained on the property for not fewer
25 ~~less~~ than 24 hours before ~~prior to~~ the towing or removal of any
26 vehicles or vessels.
