The purpose of the program is to provide grant assistance to state universities and Florida College System institutions for the development of high-quality, low-cost open educational resources for students. The term "open educational resources" means licensed (b) teaching, learning, and research resources that reside in the public domain or have been released under a license that allows their free use, reuse, modification, and sharing with others. The term includes open-access textbooks and instructional materials. (2) A state university or Florida College System institution may submit an application in a format prescribed by the department to be awarded a grant under the program. The department, in coordination with the Board of Governors and the State Board of Education, shall consider each proposal and may award grants to state universities and Florida College System institutions that demonstrate, to the satisfaction of the department and the boards, a plan for the development of open educational resources. (3) Each participating state university or Florida College System institution shall use the grant to curate or adopt open educational resources for general education courses. In curating and adopting the open educational resources, each state university and Florida College System institution must give
