9	(1) In consultation with the Department of Veterans'
10	Affairs, the Board of Governors shall adopt regulations and the
11	State Board of Education shall adopt rules that create a process
12	that enables enable eligible servicemembers or veterans of the
13	United States Armed Forces to earn <u>uniform postsecondary</u>
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academic college credit across all Florida at public 14 15 postsecondary educational institutions for college-level 16 training and education acquired in the military. The regulations and rules shall include procedures for credential evaluation and 17 the uniform award of postsecondary academic college credit or 18 19 career education clock hours, including, but not limited to, equivalency and alignment of military coursework with 20 appropriate postsecondary college courses and τ course 21 descriptions, type and amount of college credit that may be 22 23 awarded, and transfer of credit. 24 (2) The Articulation Coordinating Committee shall convene a workgroup by July 15, 2020, which is responsible for 25 26 developing a process for determining postsecondary course 27 equivalencies and the minimum postsecondary credit or career 28 education clock hours that must be awarded for courses taken and 29 occupations held by individuals during their service in the 30 military. 31 The workgroup shall be composed of the following 13 (a) 32 members: 33 1. The chair of the Articulation Coordinating Committee, or his or her designee, who shall serve as chair. 34 35 2. Four members representing academic affairs administrators and faculty from state universities, appointed by 36 37 the chair of the Board of Governors.

39	administrators and faculty from Florida College System
40	institutions, appointed by the chair of the State Board of
41	Education.
42	4. Two members representing faculty from career centers,
43	appointed by the State Board of Education.
44	5. Two members representing veterans, appointed by the
45	executive director of the Department of Veterans' Affairs.
46	(b) The Office of K-20 Articulation shall provide
47	administrative support for the workgroup.
48	(c) The workgroup shall establish a process for
49	prioritizing and determining postsecondary course equivalencies
50	and the minimum postsecondary credit or career education clock
51	hours that must be awarded for courses taken and occupations
52	held by individuals during their service in the military. The
53	workgroup shall provide recommendations to the Board of
54	Governors and the State Board of Education by December 1, 2020,
55	for approval at the next meeting of each board to allow for
56	adequate public notice.
57	(d) Upon approval of the workgroup's recommendations by
