- (2) The Articulation Coordinating Committee shall convene a workgroup by July 15, 2020, which is responsible for developing a process for determining postsecondary course equivalencies and the minimum postsecondary credit that must be awarded for courses taken and occupations held by individuals during their service in the military.
- (a) The workgroup shall be composed of the following 13 members:
- 1. The chair of the Articulation Coordinating Committee, or his or her designee, who shall serve as chair.
- 2. Four members representing academic affairs administrators and faculty from state universities, appointed by the chair of the Board of Governors.

- 4. Two members representing faculty from career centers, appointed by the State Board of Education.
- 5. Two members representing veterans, appointed by the executive director of the Department of Veterans' Affairs.
- (b) The Office of K-20 Articulation shall provide administrative support for the workgroup.
- (c) The workgroup shall establish a process for prioritizing and determining postsecondary course equivalencies and the minimum credit that must be awarded for courses taken and occupations held by individuals during their service in the military. The workgroup shall provide recommendations to the Board of Governors and the State Board of Education by December 1, 2020, for approval at the next meeting of each board which allows for adequate public notice.
- (d) Upon approval of the workgroup's recommendations by the Board of Governors and State Board of Education, the Articulation Coordinating Committee shall facilitate the review of courses taken and occupations held by individuals during their service in the military for postsecondary course equivalencies and the minimum credit that must be awarded in accordance with the approved process.
