48	(1) In consultation with the Department of Veterans'
49	Affairs, the Board of Governors shall adopt regulations and the
50	State Board of Education shall adopt rules that <u>create a process</u>

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51	that enables enable eligible servicemembers or veterans of the
52	United States Armed Forces to earn <u>uniform postsecondary</u>

The list must be updated annually.
