A bill to be entitled

An act relating to high school graduation
requirements; amending s. 1003.4282, F.S.; revising
the credit requirements to earn a standard high school
diploma to include career and technical education
rather than practical arts; providing an effective
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Paragraph (e) of subsection (3) of section 1003.4282, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
 - 1003.4282 Requirements for a standard high school diploma.-
- (3) STANDARD HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA; COURSE AND ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENTS.—
- (e) One credit in fine or performing arts, speech and debate, or <u>career and technical education (CTE)</u>. <u>practical</u> <u>arts.—The practical arts course must incorporate artistic content and techniques of creativity, interpretation, and imagination. Eligible practical arts courses are identified in the Course Code Directory.</u>
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
