> WHEREAS, white supremacy and white nationalism are contrary to the ideals of the United States, which was established according to the principle that all men are created equal as stated in the Declaration of Independence, a principle that eventually would be expanded to include women after the women's suffrage movement, beginning with the Seneca Falls Convention in 1848, and

> WHEREAS, white supremacy and white nationalism are contrary to the ideals of the State of Florida, as expressed in the State Constitution, which declares that "all natural persons, female and male alike, are equal before the law and have inalienable rights, among which are the right to enjoy and defend life and liberty, to pursue happiness, to be rewarded for industry, and to acquire, possess and protect property. No person shall be deprived of any right because of race, religion, national origin, or physical disability," and

WHEREAS, recent acts of domestic terror, including acts of mass violence, have shocked and saddened our nation, and

WHEREAS, this murderous violence was perpetrated by individuals who embraced philosophies that espouse the



superiority of one group of people over another on the basis of 40 race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender 41 identity, or religion, and 42
