7 Section 1. Section 718.129, Florida Statutes, is created
8 to read:

9 718.129 Law enforcement Vehicles.--An association may not
10 prohibit a law enforcement officer, as defined in s. 943.10(1),
11 who is a unit owner, or a tenant, guest, or invitee of a unit
12 owner, from parking his or her assigned law enforcement vehicle
13 in an area where the unit owner, or tenant, guest, or invitee of
14 the unit owner, otherwise has a right to park.

17 719.131 Law enforcement vehicles.--An association may not
18 prohibit a law enforcement officer, as defined in s. 943.10(1),
19 who is a unit owner, or a tenant, guest, or invitee of a unit
20 owner, from parking his or her assigned law enforcement vehicle
21 in an area where the unit owner, or tenant, guest, or invitee of
22 the unit owner, otherwise has a right to park.

23 Section 3. Section 720.318, Florida Statutes, is created

25 720.318 Law enforcement vehicles.--An association may not
26 prohibit a law enforcement officer, as defined in s. 943.10(1),
27 who is a parcel owner, or a tenant, guest, or invitee of a
28 parcel owner, from parking his or her assigned law enforcement
29 vehicle in an area where the parcel owner, or tenant, guest, or
30 invitee of the parcel owner, otherwise has a right to park.

31 Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming law.
