- (b) The Department of Education must include the courses in the Course Code Directory.
 - (c) A course offered pursuant to this section must:
- 1. Be offered as an elective course for students in grades
 9 through 12.
- 2. Follow all state and federal laws and guidelines in maintaining religious neutrality and accommodating the diverse religious views, traditions, and perspectives of all students in the school. A course offered pursuant to this section may not endorse, favor, or promote or disfavor or show hostility toward a particular religion, religious perspective, or nonreligious faith, an objective study of the Bible and of religion.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
