



26           386.209 Regulation of smoking preempted to state.—This  
27 part expressly preempts regulation of smoking to the state and  
28 supersedes any municipal or county ordinance on the subject;  
29 however, counties may further restrict smoking within the  
30 boundaries of any public beaches or public parks that they own  
31 and school districts may further restrict smoking by persons on  
32 school district property. This section does not preclude the  
33 adoption of municipal or county ordinances that impose more  
34 restrictive regulation on the use of vapor-generating devices  
35 than is provided in this part.

36           Section 4. Section 386.2095, Florida Statutes, is created  
37 to read:

38           386.2095 Smoking prohibited in state parks.—A person may  
39 not smoke within the boundaries of a state park.

40           Section 5. Paragraph (h) of subsection (3) of section  
41 381.84, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

42           381.84 Comprehensive Statewide Tobacco Education and Use  
43 Prevention Program.—

44           (3) PROGRAM COMPONENTS AND REQUIREMENTS.—The department  
45 shall conduct a comprehensive, statewide tobacco education and  
46 use prevention program consistent with the recommendations for  
47 effective program components contained in the 1999 Best  
48 Practices for Comprehensive Tobacco Control Programs of the CDC,  
49 as amended by the CDC. The program shall include the following  
50 components, each of which shall focus on educating people,

51 particularly youth and their parents, about the health hazards  
52 of tobacco and discouraging the use of tobacco:

53 (h) Enforcement and awareness of related laws.—In  
54 coordination with the Department of Business and Professional  
55 Regulation, the program shall monitor the enforcement of laws,  
56 rules, and policies prohibiting the sale or other provision of  
57 tobacco to minors, as well as the continued enforcement of the  
58 Clean ~~Indoor~~ Air Act prescribed in chapter 386. The  
59 advertisements produced in accordance with paragraph (a) may  
60 also include information designed to make the public aware of  
61 these related laws and rules. The departments may enter into  
62 interagency agreements to carry out this program component.

63 Section 6. Section 386.211, Florida Statutes, is amended  
64 to read:

65 386.211 Public announcements in mass transportation  
66 terminals.—Announcements about the Florida Clean ~~Indoor~~ Air Act  
67 shall be made regularly over public address systems in terminals  
68 of public transportation carriers located in metropolitan  
69 statistical areas with populations over 230,000 according to the  
70 latest census. These announcements shall be made at least every  
71 30 minutes and shall be made in appropriate languages. Each  
72 announcement must include a statement to the effect that Florida  
73 is a clean ~~indoor~~ air state and that smoking and vaping are  
74 prohibited except as provided in this part.

75 Section 7. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
