7 Section 1. Section 553.843, Florida Statutes, is created
8 to read:

9 553.843 Interior building envelope insulation products.-

10 (1) For purposes of this section the term "residential
11 dwelling" includes one-family, two-family, three-family
12 residences, townhomes, residential condominiums, residential
13 cooperatives, apartments, residential manufactured buildings,
14 residential modular buildings, residential factory buildings,
15 and mobile homes.

16 (2) Any person who manufacturers a product that is
17 advertised, sold, offered, provided, distributed, or marketed as
18 interior building envelope insulation for residential dwellings,
19 not including pipe insulation or duct insulation, without a
20 valid test report from a commission-approved testing laboratory
21 indicating that the product complies with the Florida Building
22 Code and the ASTM International standard for the product as
23 provided by Federal Trade Commission regulations in 16 C.F.R.
24 ss. 460.1, et. seq., is subject to the Florida Deceptive and
25 Unfair Trade Practices Act under part II of chapter 501, if
26 brought by the enforcing authority as defined in s. 501.203. The
27 test report for interior building envelope insulation products
28 for residential dwellings must be provided, upon request, to a
29 local building official. A product evaluation report may not be
30 used in lieu of the test report. For purposes of this section,
31 "manufacture" has the same meaning as provided in 553.36(12).

32 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
