## Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert: Section 1. Subsection (9) of section 380.0552, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

380.0552 Florida Keys Area; protection and designation as area of critical state concern.-

(9) MODIFICATION TO PLANS AND REGULATIONS.-

Any land development regulation or element of a local (a) comprehensive plan in the Florida Keys Area may be enacted, amended, or rescinded by a local government, but the enactment, amendment, or rescission becomes effective only upon approval by the state land planning agency. 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17 compliance with the principles for guiding development specified 18 in chapter 27F-8, Florida Administrative Code, as amended 19 effective August 23, 1984, and must approve or reject the 20 requested changes within 60 days after receipt. Amendments to 21 local comprehensive plans in the Florida Keys Area must also be 22 reviewed for compliance with the following:

23 1. Construction schedules and detailed capital financing 24 plans for wastewater management improvements in the annually 25 adopted capital improvements element, and standards for the 26 construction of wastewater treatment and disposal facilities or collection systems that meet or exceed the criteria in s. 27 28 403.086(10) for wastewater treatment and disposal facilities or 29 s. 381.0065(4)(1) for onsite sewage treatment and disposal 30 systems.

31 2. Goals, objectives, and policies to protect public 32 safety and welfare in the event of a natural disaster by 33 maintaining a hurricane evacuation clearance time for permanent 34 residents of no more than <u>30</u> <del>24</del> hours. The hurricane evacuation 35 clearance time shall be determined by a hurricane evacuation 36 study conducted in accordance with a professionally accepted 37 methodology and approved by the state land planning agency.

(b) The state land planning agency, after consulting with the appropriate local government, may, no more than once per year, recommend to the Administration Commission the enactment, amendment, or rescission of a land development regulation or

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42 element of a local comprehensive plan. Within 45 days following 43 the receipt of such recommendation, the commission shall reject 44 the recommendation, or accept it with or without modification 45 and adopt it by rule, including any changes. Such local 46 development regulation or plan must be in compliance with the 47 principles for guiding development.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
