An act relating to exposure of sexual organs; amending s. 800.03, F.S.; revising criminal penalties for exposure of sexual organs in certain circumstances; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 800.03, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

800.03 Exposure of sexual organs.-

- (1) It is unlawful to expose or exhibit one's sexual organs in public or on the private premises of another, or so near thereto as to be seen from such private premises, in a vulgar or indecent manner, or to be naked in public except in any place provided or set apart for that purpose. Violation of this subsection section is a felony misdemeanor of the third first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, or s. 775.084.
- (2) It is unlawful to be naked in public except in any place provided or set apart for that purpose. Violation of this subsection is a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
- (3) A mother's breastfeeding of her baby does not under any circumstance violate this section.
