1 House Memorial 2 A memorial to the Congress of the United States, 3 urging the federal government to designate certain drug cartels as foreign terrorist organizations. 4 5 6 WHEREAS, the border of the United States presents unique 7 challenges and threats to the national security of the country, 8 and 9 WHEREAS, transnational criminal organizations, commonly 10 known as drug cartels, control the majority of the flow of opioids, heroin, methamphetamine, and cocaine into this country 11 12 and this state and these groups maintain territorial influence 13 over large regions used for the cultivation, production, 14 importation, and transportation of these illicit drugs, and WHEREAS, the drug cartels are also responsible for the 15 16 proliferation of human trafficking in the United States, 17 particularly in this state, as an integrated part of their drug 18 trafficking operations, and 19 WHEREAS, the drug cartels currently conduct operations on United States soil in furtherance of drug trafficking and human 20 21 trafficking, and WHEREAS, abuse of opioids, including fentanyl, and human 22 trafficking are identified as direct threats to the economy, 23 24 well-being, and overall vitality of this state and its 25 residents, as well as future generations, and Page 1 of 2

26 WHEREAS, section 219 of the Immigration and Nationality Act 27 authorizes the United States Secretary of State, in consultation 28 with the Secretary of the Treasury and the Attorney General, to 29 designate an organization as a foreign terrorist organization 30 when certain criteria are met, and

31 WHEREAS, these drug cartels meet the criteria to be 32 designated foreign terrorist organizations, given that they are 33 foreign in nature, they engage in or retain the capability and 34 intent to engage in terrorism, and they threaten the security of 35 United States nationals and the national defense, foreign 36 relations, and economic interests of the United States, NOW, 37 THEREFORE,

39 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 40

That the House of Representatives, respectfully urges the federal government to designate the drug cartels as foreign terrorist organizations so that the government may use appropriate means to mitigate and eventually eliminate their operations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be dispatched to the President of the United States, to the President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, and to each member of the Florida delegation to the United States Congress.
