Section 1. Paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (5) of section 318.18, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

318.18 Amount of penalties. - The penalties required for a noncriminal disposition pursuant to s. 318.14 or a criminal offense listed in s. 318.17 are as follows:

(5)(a) Two One hundred dollars for a violation of s. 316.172(1)(a), failure to stop for a school bus. If, at a



hearing, the alleged offender is found to have committed this offense, the court shall impose a minimum civil penalty of \$200 \$100. In addition to this penalty, for a second or subsequent offense within a period of 5 years, the department shall suspend the driver license of the person for not less than 180 90 days and not more than 1 year 6 months.

(b) Four Two hundred dollars for a violation of s. 316.172(1)(b), passing a school bus on the side that children enter and exit when the school bus displays a stop signal. If, at a hearing, the alleged offender is found to have committed this offense, the court shall impose a minimum civil penalty of \$400 \$200. In addition to this penalty, for a second or subsequent offense within a period of 5 years, the department shall suspend the driver license of the person for not less than 360 $\frac{180}{180}$ days and not more than 2 years $\frac{1}{1}$ year.
