

1 A bill to be entitled

2 An act relating to driver licenses and identification
3 cards; amending s. 322.08, F.S.; requiring application
4 forms for original, renewal, and replacement driver
5 licenses and identification cards to include language
6 allowing a voluntary contribution to the Live Like
7 Bella Childhood Cancer Foundation; amending s. 322.14,
8 F.S.; authorizing a person with specified disabilities
9 to have the capital letter "D" placed on his or her
10 driver license under certain circumstances; providing
11 requirements for the placement of such letter on, or
12 the removal of such letter from, a person's driver
13 license; providing an effective date.

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15 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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17 Section 1. Subsection (8) of section 322.08, Florida
18 Statutes, is amended to read:

19 322.08 Application for license; requirements for license
20 and identification card forms.—

21 (8) The application form for an original, renewal, or
22 replacement driver license or identification card must include
23 language permitting the following:

24 (a) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
25 contribution shall be deposited into the Health Care Trust Fund

26 | for organ and tissue donor education and for maintaining the
27 | organ and tissue donor registry.

28 | (b) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
29 | shall be distributed to the Florida Council of the Blind.

30 | (c) A voluntary contribution of \$2 per applicant, which
31 | shall be distributed to the Hearing Research Institute,
32 | Incorporated.

33 | (d) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
34 | shall be distributed to the Juvenile Diabetes Foundation
35 | International.

36 | (e) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
37 | shall be distributed to the Children's Hearing Help Fund.

38 | (f) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
39 | shall be distributed to Family First, a nonprofit organization.

40 | (g) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Stop
41 | Heart Disease, which shall be distributed to the Florida Heart
42 | Research Institute, a nonprofit organization.

43 | (h) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Senior
44 | Vision Services, which shall be distributed to the Florida
45 | Association of Agencies Serving the Blind, Inc., a not-for-
46 | profit organization.

47 | (i) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for
48 | services for persons with developmental disabilities, which
49 | shall be distributed to The Arc of Florida.

50 | (j) A voluntary contribution of \$1 to the Ronald McDonald

51 House, which shall be distributed each month to Ronald McDonald
52 House Charities of Tampa Bay, Inc.

53 (k) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution
54 of \$1 per applicant, which shall be distributed to the League
55 Against Cancer/La Liga Contra el Cancer, a not-for-profit
56 organization.

57 (l) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to
58 Prevent Child Sexual Abuse, which shall be distributed to
59 Lauren's Kids, Inc., a nonprofit organization.

60 (m) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
61 shall be distributed to Prevent Blindness Florida, a not-for-
62 profit organization, to prevent blindness and preserve the sight
63 of the residents of this state.

64 (n) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution
65 of \$1 per applicant to the state homes for veterans, to be
66 distributed on a quarterly basis by the department to the
67 Operations and Maintenance Trust Fund within the Department of
68 Veterans' Affairs.

69 (o) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to the
70 Disabled American Veterans, Department of Florida, which shall
71 be distributed quarterly to Disabled American Veterans,
72 Department of Florida, a nonprofit organization.

73 (p) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for
74 Autism Services and Supports, which shall be distributed to
75 Achievement and Rehabilitation Centers, Inc., Autism Services

76 Fund.

77 (q) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to
78 Support Our Troops, which shall be distributed to Support Our
79 Troops, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit organization.

80 (r) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution
81 of \$1 per applicant to aid the homeless. Contributions made
82 pursuant to this paragraph shall be deposited into the Grants
83 and Donations Trust Fund of the Department of Children and
84 Families and used by the State Office on Homelessness to
85 supplement grants made under s. 420.622(4) and (5), provide
86 information to the public about homelessness in the state, and
87 provide literature for homeless persons seeking assistance.

88 (s) A voluntary contribution of \$1 or more per applicant
89 to End Breast Cancer, which shall be distributed to the Florida
90 Breast Cancer Foundation.

91 (t) A voluntary contribution of \$1 or more per applicant
92 to Childhood Cancer Care, which shall be distributed to the Live
93 Like Bella Childhood Cancer Foundation.

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95 A statement providing an explanation of the purpose of the trust
96 funds shall also be included. For the purpose of applying the
97 service charge provided under s. 215.20, contributions received
98 under paragraphs (b)-(t) ~~(b)-(s)~~ are not income of a revenue
99 nature.

100 Section 2. Paragraph (f) is added to subsection (1) of

101 section 322.14, Florida Statutes, to read:

102 322.14 Licenses issued to drivers.—

104 (f)1. Upon request by a person who has a developmental
105 disability, or by a parent or legal guardian of a child or ward
106 who has a developmental disability, the capital letter "D" shall
107 be exhibited on the driver license of a person who has a
108 developmental disability, as defined in s. 393.063, if the
109 person, or his or her parent or legal guardian, presents
110 sufficient proof that the person has been diagnosed with a
111 developmental disability by a physician licensed under chapter
112 458 or chapter 459 as determined by the department.

113 2. Until a person's driver license is next renewed, the
114 person, or his or her parent or legal guardian, may have the
115 capital letter "D" added to or removed from his or her license
116 upon the surrender of his or her current license and
117 presentation of sufficient proof that the person has been
118 diagnosed with a developmental disability by a physician
119 licensed under chapter 458 or chapter 459 as determined by the
120 department. If the applicant is not conducting any other
121 transaction affecting the driver license, a replacement license
122 may be issued with the capital letter "D" added or removed
123 without payment of the fee required in s. 322.21(1)(e).

124 Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
