16	Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 255.0991, Florida
17	Statutes, is amended to read:

20	(2) For <u>any</u> $a$ competitive solicitation for construction
21	services <u>paid for with any</u> <del>in which 50 percent or more of the</del>
22	cost will be paid from state-appropriated funds which have been
23	appropriated at the time of the competitive solicitation, a
24	state college, county, municipality, school district, or other
25	political subdivision of the state may not use a local ordinance
26	or regulation to prevent a certified, licensed, or registered
27	contractor, subcontractor, or material supplier or carrier from
28	participating in the bidding process that provides a preference
29	based upon:

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30	(a) <del>The contractor's</del> Maintaining an office or place of
31	business within a particular local jurisdiction;
32	(b) <del>The contractor's</del> Hiring employees or subcontractors
33	from within a particular local jurisdiction; or

41	(b) "Public works project" means an activity <u>exceeding \$1</u>
42	million in value which is <mark>of which 50 percent or more of the</mark>
43	<del>cost will be</del> paid <u>for with any</u> <del>from</del> state-appropriated funds
44	that were appropriated at the time of the competitive
45	solicitation and which consists of the construction,
46	maintenance, repair, renovation, remodeling, or improvement of a
47	building, road, street, sewer, storm drain, water system, site
48	development, irrigation system, reclamation project, gas or
49	electrical distribution system, gas or electrical substation, or
50	other facility, project, or portion thereof that is owned in
51	whole or in part by any political subdivision.

75	to perform such work <u>which</u> <del>who</del> is qualified, licensed, or
76	certified as required by state <u>or local</u> law to perform such work
77	from receiving information about public works opportunities or
78	from submitting a bid on the public works project. This
79	paragraph does not apply to vendors listed under ss. 287.133 and

82	This section does not apply to a program authorized by s.
83	212.055(1) which is approved by a majority vote of the
84	electorate of the county or by a charter amendment approved by a
85	majority vote of the electorate of the county.
