1. The character development curriculum shall stress the qualities of patriotism; responsibility; citizenship; kindness; respect for authority, life, liberty, and personal property; honesty; charity; self-control; racial, ethnic, and religious tolerance; and cooperation.

The character development curriculum for grades 9 through 12 shall, at a minimum, include instruction on 28 29 developing leadership skills, interpersonal skills, organization 30 skills, and research skills; creating a resume; developing and 31 practicing the skills necessary for employment interviews; 32 conflict resolution, workplace ethics, and workplace law; 33 managing stress and expectations; and developing skills that enable students to become more resilient and self-motivated. 34

35 <u>3. The character development curriculum for grades 11 and</u> 36 <u>12 shall include instruction on voting using the uniform primary</u> 37 <u>and general election ballot described in s. 101.151(9).</u>
