21	school shall provide, to a parent who initially enrolls his or
22	her child in the school, information on the important role water
23	safety education courses and swimming lessons play in saving
24	lives. The information must be provided electronically or in
25	hardcopy and must include local options for age-appropriate

water safety courses and swimming lessons that result in a
certificate indicating successful completion, including courses
and lessons offered for free or at a reduced price. If the
student is 18 or older, or is under the age of 21 and is

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
