Any data that relates to the contract must be stored in at least one 79 80 common format approved by the department, and such data remains 81 the property of the department. Any vehicle-monitoring hardware 82 installed in a state-owned motor vehicle must be commercially 83 available and may not be proprietary to the vendor or 84 contractor.
