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26 initiated conversion of the district to a municipality, NOW, 27 THEREFORE, 28 29 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 30 Section 1. Effective October 1, 2021, section 2 of section 31 32 3 of chapter 2002-330, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapter 33 2008-272, Laws of Florida, is amended to read: 34 Section 2. 312	continuationThe Indian Trail Improvement District, an
313	independent special district created by a special act of the
314	Legislature, shall continue as an independent special district
315	for those lands which are subject to outstanding indebtedness
316	until such time as the termination of such indebtedness or the
317	transition date mutually agreed to by the municipality and the
318	district. Until the transition date:
319	(1) The assets, liabilities, and written contracts of the
320	district, including all rights, obligations, duties, and
321	relationships now existing by law or agreement, shall be
322	unaffected and shall remain in full force and effect.
323	(2) To the extent such procedures are not inconsistent
324	with this charter, all resolutions and policies of the district
325	shall remain in effect until amended, revised, or terminated.
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326 Section 3. Except as otherwise provided in this act, this 327 act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
