Representative Aloupis offered the following:

Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 127-134 and insert:

Effective July 1, 2030, and every 10 years thereafter, the \$50,000 jurisdictional limit in subparagraph 3. must be adjusted and increased by the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers, U.S. City Average, All Items, 1982-1984=100, or successor reports, for the preceding 10 calendar years as initially reported by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics. The adjusted jurisdictional limit must be rounded to the nearest \$5,000. However, the jurisdictional limit may not be lower than \$50,000. The Office of Economic and Demographic Research must calculate

17 the adjusted jurisdictional limit and certify the adjusted
18 jurisdictional limit to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court
19 beginning January 31, 2030, and every 10 years thereafter. The
20 Office of Economic and Demographic Research and the Office of
21 the State Courts Administrator must publish the adjusted
22 jurisdictional limit on their websites.
