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14	Section 1. Subsection (4) of section 3 and section 10 of
15	section 3 of chapter 2003-354, Laws of Florida, are amended to

17	Section 3. District governing board
18	(4) In the event of a vacancy, due to any cause, on the
19	Board of Commissioners, the vacancy shall be filled for the
20	remainder of the term by the remaining Commissioners, or if they
21	<u>fail to act</u> special election within 30 days after the occurrence
22	of the vacancy, the vacancy shall be filled by a special unless
23	the vacancy occurs within 90 days after a regular election.
24	Section 10. Construction contracts.—All work done by the
25	District in the construction, reconstruction, repair,
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26 maintenance, improvement, or enlargement of such water supply 27 and distribution system involving the expenditure of more than 28 \$35,000 \$5,000 shall be done by contract entered into following 29 advertisement for bids received on a stated date pursuant to 30 notice for sealed bids published at least once each week for 2 31 consecutive weeks in a newspaper or journal of general 32 circulation among contractors in the State of Florida, and all 33 such contracts shall be secured by performance bonds in an amount not less than 80 percent of the contract price, furnished 34 35 by a surety company or companies authorized to do business in the State of Florida. If the governing board of the District 36 37 determines in writing that an immediate danger to the public health, safety, or welfare, or a substantial loss, requires 38 39 emergency action, the District may proceed with the procurement 40 of contractual services necessitated by the immediate danger, 41 without receiving competitive sealed bids, after receiving 42 pricing information from at least two prospective vendors. 43 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
