54	credential viewable on an electronic credentialing system.

(d) "Limited profile" means an electronic credential 64 65 containing some, but not all, of the information displayed on a printed driver license or identification card. 66 67 (e) "Scanning" means obtaining data from a digital proof of 68 driver license or identification card in an electronic format. 69 (2) (a) The department shall establish begin to review and prepare for the development of a secure and uniform system for 70 71 issuing an optional digital proof of driver license or 72 identification card. The department may contract with one or 73 more private entities to develop an electronic credentialing a 74 digital proof of driver license system. 75 (b) The electronic credentialing system may not retain Internet protocol addresses, geo<u>location data, or other</u> 76 77 information that describes the location, computer, computer 78 system, or computer network from which a customer accesses the 79 system. 80 (3) (a) $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$ The digital proof of driver license or 81 identification card established developed by the department or 82 by an entity contracted by the department must be in such a format as to allow verification of law enforcement to verify the 83 authenticity of the digital proof of driver license or 84 85 identification card. The department may adopt rules to ensure valid authentication of digital driver licenses and 86 87 identification cards by law enforcement.

100	<u>(4)</u> A person may not be issued a digital proof of driver
101	license <u>or identification card</u> until he or she <u>satisfies all</u> has

104	card and has been issued a printed driver license or
105	identification card. The electronic credentialing system must,

123	verification through the electronic credentialing system that

127	electronic credentials.
128	(7)(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), a private
129	entity that scans a digital proof of driver license or
130	identification card may not store, sell, or share personal
131	information collected from such scanning of the digital proof of

133	(b) An individual may consent to allow a private entity to
134	collect and store personal information obtained by scanning his
135	or her digital proof of driver license or identification card.
136	However, the individual must be informed what information is
137	collected and the purpose or purposes for which the information
138	will be used. If the individual does not want the private entity
139	to scan his or her digital proof of the individual's driver
140	license or identification card, the private entity may manually
141	collect personal information from the individual.

(2) For each licensee whose driving record does not show
any revocations, disqualifications, or suspensions for the

(a) Failure to exhibit a vehicle registration certificate,
