17 fiscal years, if available. By November 1, 2022, and each year
18 thereafter if applicable, each agency shall submit a
19 supplemental data file to the University of Florida Anita Zucker
20 Center for Excellence in Early Childhood Studies containing
21 program service data from the preceding federal fiscal year.

22 (b) The Department of Children and Families shall assist
23 the University of Florida Anita Zucker Center for Excellence in
24 Early Childhood Studies with receiving information required to
25 be analyzed under subsection (1) that is related to the
26 department's programs, including but not limited to providing
27 assistance with seeking any required approvals or waivers from
28 applicable federal agencies.

29 (5) The University of Florida Anita Zucker Center for
30 Excellence in Early Childhood Studies shall provide a report to
31 the Office of Early Learning based on the results of its
32 analysis by May 31 of each year.

33 (6) The Office of Early Learning within 30 days after
34 receiving the report shall submit it to the Governor, the
35 President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of
36 Representatives.

37 (7) This section expires on June 30, 2023, unless reviewed
38 and reenacted by the Legislature before that date.
