24	(1) The department shall develop and implement a state
25	nutrition assistance reimbursement program for the purpose of
26	reimbursing eligible community-based nonprofit organizations or
27	nonprofit religious organizations operating under s. 501(c)(3)
28	of the Internal Revenue Code for administrative costs directly
29	incurred in providing enrollment assistance services for food

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30	assistance programs, such as the Supplemental Nutrition
31	Assistance Program and the Special Supplemental Nutrition
32	Program for Women, Infants, and Children.
33	(2) The department shall determine eligibility criteria and
34	application procedures for the program. An eligible community-
35	based nonprofit organization or nonprofit religious organization
36	shall submit to the department an application on a form
