23	school board composed of five or more members chosen by vote of
24	the electors in a nonpartisan election for appropriately
25	staggered terms of four years, as provided by law.

The school board shall operate, control and supervise 26 (b) all free public schools within the school district and determine 27 28 the rate of school district taxes within the limits prescribed 29 herein.
