## House Memorial

A memorial to the Federal Emergency Management Agency, urging the agency to amend the proposed rule entitled "Cost of Assistance Estimates in the Disaster Declaration Process for the Public Assistance Program" to provide for a gradual increase in the per capita indicator.

WHEREAS, since 1986, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has used a \$1 per capita indicator to evaluate the estimated cost of federal and nonfederal public assistance against the statewide population to determine the need for federal disaster assistance, and

WHEREAS, at the time, FEMA believed that the federal disaster public assistance threshold was a level of damage from which even the least populated state could recover using state resources, and

WHEREAS, in December 2020, FEMA published a proposed rule entitled "Cost of Assistance Estimates in the Disaster Declaration Process for the Public Assistance Program," and

WHEREAS, under the proposed rule, Florida's proposed per capita would increase to \$1.98, and

WHEREAS, using the new formula in the proposed rule, Florida would be required to sustain damages exceeding \$42,172,664 to be eligible for a federal disaster declaration,

which is an increase of 49.5 percent from the state's current baseline, and

WHEREAS, the state agrees with FEMA that the changes would provide a better distribution of responsibilities between the states and the federal government and would incentivize states to invest more in disaster response, recovery, and mitigation capabilities, and

WHEREAS, the state is facing budget challenges due to the pandemic and impending hurricane season, and

WHEREAS, the significant increase to the state's per capita indicator under the proposed rule would make the state vulnerable to significant hardship, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the Federal Emergency Management Agency is urged to amend the proposed rule entitled "Cost of Assistance Estimates in the Disaster Declaration Process for the Public Assistance Program" to provide for a gradual increase in the per capita indicator.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be dispatched to the President of the United States, to the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency, to the President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, and to each member of
