1 House Memorial 2 A memorial to the President of the United States and 3 the Congress of the United States, urging the President and Congress to denounce the January 6, 4 5 2021, domestic terrorism incident at the United States 6 Capitol. 7 8 WHEREAS, the United States is committed to defending 9 democratic institutions and the integrity of the election system 10 and to ensuring the security of the people and facilities that 11 carry out the democratic process, and 12 WHEREAS, the January 6, 2021, domestic terrorism incident 13 at our nation's Capitol does not reflect the values of the 14 United States, and WHEREAS, the Anti-Defamation League's report "Murder and 15 Extremism in the United States in 2019" found that domestic 16 17 extremists killed at least 42 people in the United States in 17 18 separate incidents in 2019, making 2019 the sixth-deadliest year 19 on record for domestic extremist-related murders since 1970, and WHEREAS, the report found that all but one of those murders 20 21 were tied to right-wing extremists, and 81 percent were committed by white supremacists, and 22 WHEREAS, misinformation, disinformation, and online 23 24 conspiracy theories such as QAnon are spreading and inspiring 25 real violence, and

26 WHEREAS, the United States supports the right of all people 27 to peacefully exercise free speech, free assembly, and freedom 28 to worship, NOW, THEREFORE, 29 30 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 31 32 That the President of the United States and the Congress of 33 the United States are urged to denounce the January 6, 2021, domestic terrorism incident at the United States Capitol. 34 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be 36 dispatched to the President of the United States, to the 37 President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the 38 United States House of Representatives, and to each member of 39 the Florida delegation to the United States Congress.
