- (c) Adequate food supply in case of emergency. Each correctional institution shall establish a program with one or more community food banks located near the institution to ensure adequate food supply is made available to the inmate population when and if conditions exist that prevent regular food supply services in the event of a natural disaster or other emergency.
 - (d) Necessary heath supplies. The department must provide:
- 1. Necessary personal protective equipment for medical staff at all times and for all staff and inmates during health crises or during any cleaning.
- Necessary health products for inmates including, but not limited to, sanitary napkins, tampons, soap, and toothpaste, upon request of inmates.
- (2) The department shall provide a written copy of the rights established in this section to each inmate upon his or her entry in to the correctional system.
- (3) An inmate may file a grievance with the department if the inmate believes a right guaranteed in this section is denied by a correctional institution.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
