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Senator Brodeur moved the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

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Delete lines 230 - 242

and insert:

(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), an individual's "weekly benefit amount" is an amount equal to one twenty-sixth of the total wages for insured work paid during that quarter of the base period in which the total wages paid were the highest, but not less than \$100 \$32 or more than \$375 \$275. The weekly benefit amount, if not a multiple of \$1, is rounded downward to the nearest full dollar amount. The maximum weekly benefit



amount in effect at the time the claimant establishes an individual weekly benefit amount is the maximum benefit amount applicable throughout the claimant's benefit year.

(b) If an individual's weekly benefit calculated pursuant to paragraph (a) would result in a weekly benefit amount of less than \$100, the individual's weekly benefit amount may not exceed one-thirteenth of the total wages for insured work paid during the quarter of the base period in which the total wages paid were the highest.
