Section 3. Subsection (2) of section 877.19, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

877.19 Hate Crimes Reporting Act.—

(2) ACQUISITION AND PUBLICATION OF DATA.—The Governor, through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, shall collect and disseminate data on incidents of criminal acts that evidence

11 prejudice based on race, religion, ethnicity, color, ancestry,
12 sexual orientation, gender, gender identity, disability, or
13 national origin. All law enforcement agencies shall report
14 monthly to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement concerning
15 such offenses in such form and in such manner as prescribed by
16 rules adopted by the department. Such information shall be
17 compiled by the department and disseminated upon request to any
18 local law enforcement agency, unit of local government, or state
19 agency.
